

## **KEY CITY PUBLIC THEATRE SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS**

### **APPLICATION PACKET**

Annual Scholarship Period: September 1 – August 31

The mission of the Key City Public Theatre Scholarship Awards is to assist emerging theatre artists who are continuing their education in pursuit of a theatre career.

- Scholarships are awarded to graduating high school seniors or continuing college students who will pursue an education in the field of drama.
- Scholarships are awarded to actors, directors, playwrights, and costume, set, sound and lighting designers who have been involved in KCPT productions.
- All applications must include a letter of recommendation. Recommendations will be accepted from Artistic Directors of theatre companies, Directors of KCPT productions, and Teachers, Deans or Professors of Theatre Arts programs.
- Scholarships will typically range from \$1000.00 \$1500.00. KCPT may elect to forward the scholarship award directly to the applicant's educational institution.
- Scholarships are for tuition assistance only (not to include living expenses, room and board, etc) for professional training at a non-profit school located in the United States.
- All candidates must be United States citizens and have permanent residence status in Jefferson or Clallam County.
- Candidates may submit only one scholarship application to KCPT per calendar year.

Applications must be postmarked no later than April 30 each year and should be addressed to:

#### Applicant's personal statement:

Please describe, in your own words, the dreams and desires you hold for your role as a theatre artist now and in the future. (Not to exceed one page; minimum font 12pt)

Although not required, **submission of additional material** that you feel may be of interest to the committee is highly recommended. This includes:

• Video recordings, maximum 5 minutes, highlighting the applicant's work as a performer or director/designer and demonstrating their range of ability. Please indicate time stamp of pertinent performance footage.

Photographs of work, press releases, reviews, etc. with pertinent passages underlined.An additional letter of recommendation from a theatre colleague or instructor.
